The procedure is to meditate on the two Letters

Bet Tzadi

The letter Tzadi creates the Mazel or constellation Aquarius

(דלי). Dali is the Hebrew word for Water Carrier.

The Bet is the letter that creates the planet Saturn (שבתאי).

and then read The verses from the Torah are the Portion of Naso - specifically Bamidbar Chapter 7 Verse 72-77. If you can not read Hebrew it is OK to just scan the letters in the sequence right to left, top to bottom.

Each Tribe of Israel has a Leader called a Nasi. Asher is the tribe that is connected to the month of Shevat. We are taught in both the Talmud and Zohar and other Sages to Permute the Letters of someone's Name to understand more about what that person is about. Below is a partial permutation for the Leader of the Tribe of Benjamin

The full name for the Nasi of the Tribe of Asher is Pageail Ben Achran spelled פִּגְעִיאֵל בֶּן עַכְרָן

the Shores of Ayin Caf Resh means to make turbid, to befoul, to disturb, to trouble, to roil (liquid)

Then name of this Nasi means "to plead son of trouble"

It is up to you to put these combination of Names together

to get deeper understanding about the people involved in the dedication. The sages have made commentaries indicating that not all of these names are complimentary in order for us to learn the areas of our lives that need improvement.

For additional depth, one can also utilize the Name Form on www.Yeshshem.com to read the Verses that have the energy essence of these people.

Within the above Verses the contribution that was brought by the Nasi for the Tribe of Asher is explained. Each of the 12 Leaders (Nasi) brought the same items, but with different consciousness and the Torah spends many Letters teaching us their meaning.

There is one additional tool to assist us on this day. Each day of the year there are Tzadikim (Righteous People) who have chosen to leave this world on a particular day. There is a connection between these souls and this day. They ask us to utilize their connection to strengthen our own connection to our spiritual actions during this day. The more one learns about a particular Tzadik, the better is ones connection to their connection. All these actions are bringing us closer to Hashem.

The Tzadikim who died on Yood Aleph Nissan are:

Rabbi Moshe ben Nachman, the Ramban (1270 which is the year 5030 in the Hebrew Calendar).

Rabbi Yeshaya ben Rabbi Avrohom Halevi Horowitz, the Shelah (1630 which is the year 5390 in the Hebrew Calendar)

R' Shlomo Zalman Lipschitz, Chemdas Shlomo (1839 which is the year 5599 in the Hebrew Calendar)

Rabbi Betzalel Hakohen of Vilna, Mareh Kohen
