The procedure is to meditate on the two Letters

**Yood Resh**

**The letter Yood creates the Mazel or constellation**

**Virgo (בתולה). Betulah is the Hebrew word for the concept of Virgin.**

**The Resh is the letter that creates the planet Mercury (כוכב). The Gematria of Resh and Yood is 210. this is the same Gematria as the word Redu which means "to go down". This refers to HaShem going down to be closer to us in order for us to do Tshuva which is easier in the month of Elul.**

and then read The verses from the Torah are the Portion of Naso - specifically Bamidbar Chapter 7 Verse 42-47. If you can not read Hebrew it is OK to just scan the letters in the sequence right to left, top to bottom.

Each Tribe of Israel has a Leader called a Nasi. Gad is the tribe that is connected to the month of Av. We are taught in both the Talmud and Zohar and other Sages to Permute the Letters of someone's Name to understand more about what that person is about. Below is a partial permutation for the Leader of the Tribe of Gad.

The full name for the Nasi of the Tribe of Gad is Elyasaf Ben Deoel.

to add on, to increase, to augment, to repeat, to continue, appreciating currency

בן

דעואל

to know, to perceive, to consider, to understand, to become acquainted with, to become familiar with, to be skillful, to be aware, to concern, to have sexual relations with. It can also be the Knowledge of His God.

It is up to you to put these combination of Names together to get deeper understanding about the people involved in the dedication. The sages have made commentaries indicating that not all of these names are complimentary in order for us to learn the areas of our lives that need improvement.

For additional depth, one can also utilize the Name Form on [www.Yeshshem.com](http://www.Yeshshem.com) to read the Verses that have the energy essence of these people.

Within the above Verses the contribution that was brought by the Nasi for the Tribe of Gad is explained. Each of the 12 Leaders (Nasi) brought the same items, but with different consciousness and the Torah spends many Letters teaching us their meaning.

There is one additional tool to assist us on this day. Each day of the year there are Tzadikim (Righteous People) who have chosen to leave this world on a particular day. There is a connection between these souls and this day. They ask us to utilize their connection to strengthen our own connection to our spiritual actions during this day. The

more one learns about a particular Tzadik, the better is ones connection to their connection. All these actions are bringing us closer to Hashem.

The Tzadikim who died on Vav Nissan are:

Rabbi Aharon ben Rabbi Shmuel Yaakov Roth, Shomer Emunim (1947 which is 5707 in the Hebrew Calendar) The Shomer Emunim, Toldos Ahron and Toldos Avrohom Yitzchok dynasties come from him.

Rabbi Meir Don Plotsky, author of Kli Chemda (1928 which is the year 5687 in the Hebrew Calendar)
