The procedure is to meditate on the two Letters

Bet Ayin

The letter Ayin creates the Mazel or constellation Gdi (גדי). Gdi is the Hebrew word for the Goat.

The Bet is the letter that creates the planet Saturn (שבתאי).

The Gematria of Ayin Bet is 72. It is connected to the 72 Names of God as well as the 72 Names from the Tzadikim.

and then read The verses from the Torah are the Portion of Naso - specifically Bamidbar Chapter 7 Verse 66-71. If you can not read Hebrew it is OK to just scan the letters in the sequence right to left, top to bottom.

Each Tribe of Israel has a Leader called a Nasi. Dan is the tribe that is connected to the month of Tevet. We are taught in both the Talmud and Zohar and other Sages to Permute the Letters of someone's Name to understand more about what that person is about. Below is a partial permutation for the Leader of the Tribe of Benyamin

The full name for the Nasi of the Tribe of Dan is Achiezer Ben
Amishadai spelled אֲחִיעֶזֶר בֶּן עַמִּישַׁדָּי

אחיעזר

אחי

means my brother

עזר

means aid, helper, assistant, auxiliary, helpmate

- as a verb it means to help to assist to aid,

בן

son or son of

עמישדי

The full name means "the helpmate of my brother son of my God's People"

It is up to you to put these combination of Names together to get deeper understanding about the people involved in the dedication. The sages have made commentaries indicating that not all of these names are complimentary in order for us to learn the areas of our lives that need improvement.

For additional depth, one can also utilize the Name Form on www.Yeshshem.com to read the Verses that have the energy essence of these people.

Within the above Verses the contribution that was brought by the Nasi for the Tribe of Dan is explained. Each of the 12 Leaders (Nasi) brought the same items, but with different consciousness and the Torah spends many Letters teaching us their meaning.

There is one additional tool to assist us on this day. Each day of the year there are Tzadikim (Righteous People) who have chosen to leave this world on a particular day. There is a connection between these souls and this day. They ask us to utilize their connection to strengthen our own connection to our spiritual actions during this day. The more one learns about a particular Tzadik, the better is ones

connection to their connection. All these actions are bringing us closer to Hashem.

The Tzadikim who died on Yood Nissan are:

Miriam Hanevia (1270 B.C.E. which is 2490 in the Hebrew Calendar). This Miriam the Prophetess, the Siser of Moshe Rabenu and Aaron HaCohen Gadol. It is through her merit that the Well of Miriam accompanied the Children of Israel while in the desert.

Rabbi Shalom Mashash, Sephardic Rav of Yerushalayim, passed away Shabbos Hagadol 5763/2003

Teacher of Rabbi Yehudah Ashlag. He specifically requested that his name never be revealed.
