The procedure is to meditate on the two Letters

The two Hebrew Letters are:



Resh Zion

The letter Zion creates the Mazel or constellation Gemini (תאומים). Tuomim is the Hebrew word for Twins.

The Resh is the letter that creates the planet Mercury (כוכב).
The Gematria of these two letters (207) is equivalent to the Hebrew word for Light and the word RAZ means secret.

Each Tribe of Israel has a Leader called a Nasi. Zevuloon is the tribe that is connected to the month of Sivan. We are taught in both the Talmud and Zohar and other Sages to Permute the Letters of someone's Name to understand more about what that person is about. Below is a partial permutation for the Leader of the Tribe of Shimon.

The full name for the Nasi of the Tribe of Zevuloon is Eliav Ben Chalon spelled אֱלִיאָב בֶּן חֵלֹן

Aleph Beth spells Father, Aleph Lamed Yood spells My El (God), Gematria is 44 which is Mem Dalet which when spelled Dalet Mem means blood, In Aramaic Aleph Lamed Yood spells mourning,

Within the above Verses the contribution that was brought by the Nasi for the Tribe of Zevulun is explained. Each of the 12 Leaders (Nasi) brought the same items, but with different consciousness and the Torah spends many Letters teaching us their meaning.
